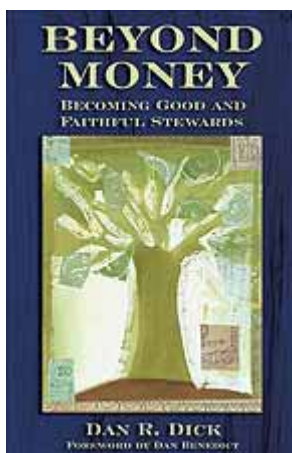


BEYOND MONEY
