MISSION CENTRAL

Started in June of 2002, Mission Central is a place where people can be the hands and feet of God in service to others. It is a place to –

- ⇒ facilitate and partner with existing or new ministries of the United Methodist Church
- ⇒ partner with other denominational and non-denominational ministries
- ⇒ provide logistical support for Volunteers in Mission (VIM) and disaster response activities.

Mission Central is committed to seeking and following the will of God for service to the world. Mission Central is involved at all local, national and international levels and is available to all thirteen Northeastern United Methodist Conferences to facilitate the collection and processing of kits for the United Methodist Committee On Relief.

Mission Central is governed by a 22-member Board of Directors elected by the Central Pennsylvania Annual Conference of the United Methodist Church. Although it is a separate entity, it is connected to the Conference through the Conference Council on Ministries with membership on the Conference Board of Global Ministries. Mission Central conducts all of its activities within the United Methodist Social Principals.

Mission Central does not automatically receive Conference funding. All the money needed to pay for the building, staffing, operations, and completing mission activities must be raised.

ENDOWMENT FUND

An initial contribution from the estate of Esther Franklin began the Mission Central Endowment Fund in November 2003.

Members and friends of Mission Central may add to the Fund through designated or undesignated memorial/honor or life-time gifts, bequests by will and in other ways. An Endowment Fund Committee of seven members of the Mission Central Board of Directors is responsible for encouraging all types of gifts to the Fund.

Written acknowledgement of gifts is made by The United Methodist Stewardship Foundation of Central Pennsylvania. They maintain a record of each gift included in the Fund and also manage the assets held in the Fund.

Income from the Endowment Fund may be used by Mission Central for any purpose relevant to the mission, ministry or operations of Mission Central.

Proposals for endowment spending may be submitted to the Endowment Fund Committee by any member or committee of the Mission Central Board of Directors. No disbursements of funds are made without approval of the Mission Central Board.
