PHILOSOPHY

“New Consecration Sunday” is a stewardship education program based on our Christian acceptance of God’s unconditional love and our need as stewards of God’s Word to make a faith commitment by giving a percentage of our income to God’s household, the Church. This is a spiritual growth program teaching giving as a response to God’s love and part of the worship act. The “New Consecration Sunday” encourages joyful giving rather than fund raising to meet a budget.

GOAL

There is a direct correlation between how Christian stewardship is defined and taught and the congregation’s giving response. The Church as the household of Christ is peopled by those who are called to know God through their stewardship walk with Jesus. The Church desires to contribute to God’s work by increasing individual giving proportionately.

BENEFITS

Teaches percentage giving as the path to growing cheerful givers. Asks, “What percentage of your income is God calling you to give?”

Refuels church members’ education about the faith connection between money and living in response to God’s love.

Results in 20 – 60% higher attendance on Consecration Sunday than usual.

Increases a Church’s financial contributions generally by 10 – 25% the first year with anticipated increases in future years.

GUEST LEADER

It is essential to have a Guest Leader conduct the “New Consecration Sunday” Program. The Guest Leader will follow the timeline, speak effectively and in an interesting manner and visit the Local Church on three separate occasions:

- #1. To meet with the members of the Consecration Sunday Team
Orientation
Six weeks before Consecration Sunday
- #2. To meet with all the leaders and their spouses
Dinner or dessert social
One week before Consecration Sunday
- #3. To speak at the Consecration Sunday Worship Service and

join the congregation for the catered Victory Luncheon (also called the Celebration Luncheon)

A Guest Leader will have experience with the Program and be able to guide your Church through the process with a fresh approach, resulting in more attention and consideration to the subject.

Since the presence of a Guest Leader makes a 10 to 20 % difference in total results, it is well worth the small honorarium and travel expense.

3. Victory Luncheon Chairperson
4. Announcer #1
5. Announcer #2
6. Announcer #3
7. Church Financial Secretary
8. Pastor

Team members may be, but are not required to be members of your Finance and/or Stewardship Committee(s). You may want to include someone to assist with mailings; your Youth Group might help with posters.
